

Payment Terms and Conditions Nudge Global Impact Challenge 2019

These Payment Terms and Conditions apply to all Support Partners that are sending one or more participants to the Nudge Global Impact Challenge 2019, which is taking place in The Netherlands on 21 - 23 October 2019.

Version 8 January 2019

1. The Participation Fee amounts to EUR 3.500,-- per Participant. This excludes:
 - (i) travel costs;
 - (ii) costs for accommodation and catering during the Nudge Global Impact Challenge for three days and two nights at Woudschoten Hotel & Conference Centre (21 - 23 October, 2019), which amounts to EUR 500,-- per Participant. The costs for accommodation and catering will be invoiced to you by Woudschoten Hotel & Conference Centre.
 - (iii) VAT: for Support Partners based in the Netherlands, the Participation Fee invoice will include VAT. For Support Partners based outside the Netherlands, VAT is not applicable.
2. Upon registration you will receive an invoice from Nudge for the Participation Fee. This invoice must be paid within two weeks of the invoice date to our business bank account, the details of which are as follows:

3. Kindly ensure payment is made within 14 days of the invoice date and please specify the invoice number with your payment. Please note that any international transfer charges or overseas delivery charges will not be borne by Nudge.
4. **Participants for whom the Participation Fee has not been received by 30 September 2019 will not be admitted to the programme.**
5. Please send the name(s) and email address(es) of your chosen Participant(s) to us via email to ilse@nudge.nl at the latest **by 1 July 2019**.
6. All cancellations of bookings must be submitted via email to ilse@nudge.nl by **2 September 2019**. If written notice is received by Nudge on or before this date, we will refund your Participation Fee with a 50% cancellation fee.
7. **After 2 September 2019, refunds are not possible.** You can either:
 - (i) send another Participant who meets the criteria; or
 - (ii) if you do not have a replacement, you can sponsor a wild card participant.

8. Nudge reserves the right to make changes to the content or the timing of the planned activities during the Nudge Global Impact Challenge.
9. Nudge reserves the right to cancel or reschedule the Nudge Global Impact Challenge at any time in the case of insufficient participants. If Nudge cancels the Challenge, you are entitled to a full refund of the Participation Fee, but Nudge will not be responsible for a refund of the costs related to travel or any expenses incurred by you as a result of such cancellation. If Nudge cancels the Challenge, you will be contacted directly.
10. In the unlikely event of the Nudge Global Impact Challenge being cancelled in its entirety by Nudge, for any reason other than a force majeure, a full refund will be made. For the purpose of this clause, 'force majeure' means any circumstances not within the reasonable control of Nudge, including, without limitation:
 - (a) any strike, lockout or other industrial action or any shortage of or difficulty in obtaining labour or venues or accommodations;
 - (b) any destruction, temporary or permanent breakdown, malfunction or damage of or to any premises plant equipment (including computer systems) or material;
 - (c) any breach of contract, default or insolvency by or of any third party (including an agent or sub-contractor) or an employee or officer of that party or company;
 - (d) any action taken by a governmental or public authority of any kind including not granting a consent exemption approval or clearance;
 - (e) any civil commotion or disorder, riot, invasion, war, acts of terrorism, threat of or preparation for war; or
 - (f) any fire, explosion, storm, flood, earthquake, subsidence, epidemic, public health crisis, or other natural physical disaster.
11. In the event of a visa application being denied, the Participation Fee is forfeited in full and there is no refund.
12. Each of the paragraphs of these Terms operates separately. If any court or relevant authority decides that any of them are unlawful, the remaining paragraphs will remain in full force and effect.
13. These Terms are governed by Dutch law and in the event of any claim or dispute, the Dutch courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
